## Physical development:

Use tools safely when working on the woodwork.

## Mathematics:

Name 2D and 3D shapes and discuss their properties.  
 Use 3D shapes  
 Use 2D shapes to make patterns.  
 Use different types of equipment to measure length  
 Ordering and counting numbers to 20.  
 Size language - Comparing different types of dinosaurs.

## Understanding the world:

Compare familiar environment with the past.  
 Fossils and the extinction of dinosaurs.
