

'Behaviour for Learning' in every classroom – Booklet for Parents

What is 'Behaviour for Learning'?

Whilst it may look different in each year group, 'behaviour for learning' develops the key skills children need to master to become **successful** learners. Our **5 key behaviours** build on our growth mind set ethos, this is not about good behaviour (which we expect at all times) but developing the correct attitudes to learning so the children know how they can become more confident learners, who always aspire to do their best.

Why is Behaviour for Learning so important?

To be a **successful learner**, each child needs to develop key skills that will enable them to access all their learning to the fullest extent. Our 5 key behaviours will **develop skills and attitudes to learning** that will put our children in good stead for the challenges they will meet throughout their lives. We are helping to build successful futures for all our children by showing them how to be **highly motivated learners**.

The five key behaviours for learning spell **CHAD'S** so that the children remember them and they are represented by five different logos and colours:

C - Collaboration

H - Hard Work

A- Aspiration

D - Determination

S - Strive (for excellence)

- Each behaviour comes with a series of 'I can...' statements to help every child master them within each phase of learning. These have been developed with the staff so the expectations and statements are age and stage appropriate.
- Every child can be rewarded with house points when they are demonstrating a behaviour well. We will also be awarding special certificates to children who shows these behaviours well in class.
