Collecting Pupils.

UNIFORM, JEWELLERY, HAIR & ACCESSORIES

The uniform for our children can be purchased at **Ziggy's** at Harpurhey Shopping Centre, M9 4DH and it is as follows:

Foundation Stage (NUR - REC)

- Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan or plain royal blue jumper/cardigan
- Black or grey skirt/pinafore or trousers
- Black/grey/dark navy tights
- Sky blue polo shirt
- Black velcro shoes

If possible Children to bring a spare change of clothes to school as well as wellington boots

Year 1 - 6 Boys

- St Chad's Primary navy sweatshirt or plain navy jumper
- Black or grey trousers
- Sky blue shirt or polo shirt
- Sensible black shoes

Year 1 - 6 Girls

- St Chad's Primary sweatshirt/cardigan or
- plain navy jumper/cardigan
- Black or grey skirt/pinafore or trousers
- Black/grey/dark navy tights
- Sky blue blouse or polo shirt
- Sensible black shoes

P.E Kit

Our indoor P.E kit consists of a simple white t-shirt, plain blue or black shorts and black pumps.

Outdoor P.E kit same as the indoor but with jogging bottoms/ tracksuit/ sweatshirt to keep warm. Training shoes- must be different from everyday shoes/ trainers.

Pupil Jewellery On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewelry in our school except one set of small, metallic stud earrings and they must be removed for PE, unless the ears have

been very recently pierced. Staff cannot remove earrings nor can the earrings be taped up. This is a health and safety procedure agreed by the Governors. No other body adornments are allowed. One watch may be worn. Staff should remove personal jewellery, before the PE lesson if possible.

ACCESSORIES: in our school. Nail polish, hair coloured extensions or extravagant hair accessories e.g. big bows are also not allowed.

Extreme Haircuts are not permitted as this could serve as a distraction to other children e.g. shaved heads, shaved designs or Mohawk cuts.

Headscarves: Headwear worn for religious reasons must be black or dark blue and is expected to only be worn in Y5 & Y6. Any issues please contact the school.
