

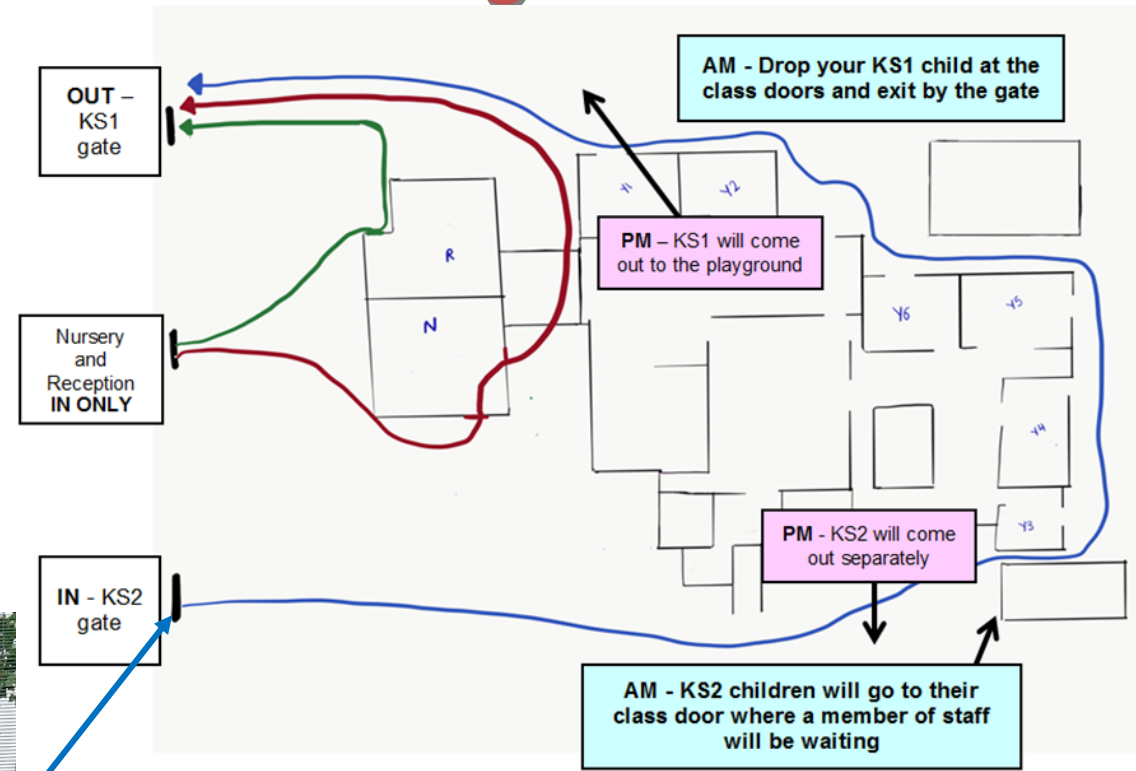


Entering School KS1 and 2

blue signs**

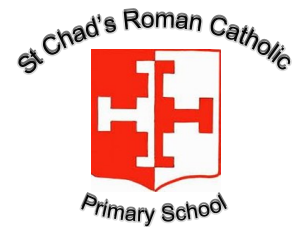
The blue signs tell you where you can enter school. For Key stage 1 and 2, you must enter the gate that says Main Reception and Key Stage 2. Gates will be open from 8.40—9.00 a.m. There won't be any breakfast club at the moment. Only one parent can drop off their child in Key Stage 1 at the classroom door. Key Stage 2 children can walk round to their classroom on their own, staff will be present to guide them. Please observe the one way system and social distancing outside school and on the school grounds, keep 2 metres from each other to keep everyone safe. Face coverings must be worn by adults unless you are medically exempt from wearing one

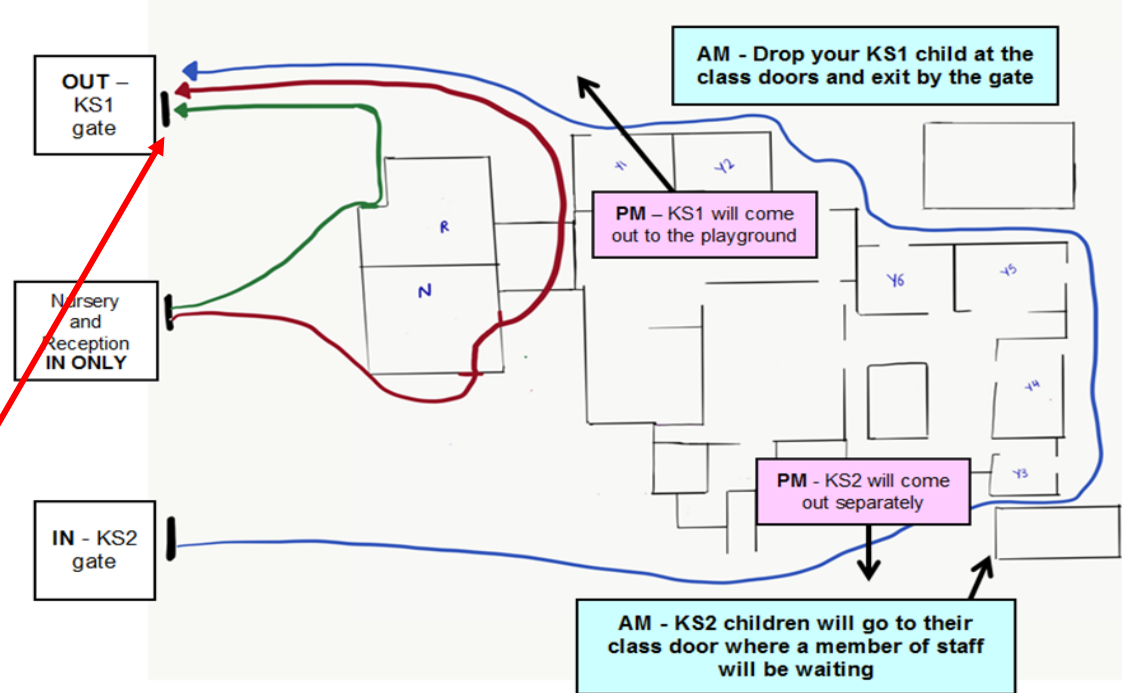
Exiting School for KS1 and KS2

The red signs tell you where you can exit school. For Key stage 1 and 2, you must exit the gate in the Key Stage 1 playground. Please observe the one way system around school to keep everyone safe. Face coverings must be worn by adults unless you are medically exempt from wearing one

At the end of the school day, the children will leave their classroom and come into the playground. Please do not wait outside the classroom door and wait on the playground observing a 2 metre distance from each other.
