Reminder – Keeping Safe In and Around School

Dear Parents

As we approach the end of term, I know some of you have been struggling with your children having to self-isolate and learning at home due to bubbles closing. With Christmas approaching, we want you to help us keep your children, families and the staff safe as nobody wants to have Covid-19 for Christmas.

The Government announced that we are in **Tier 3 (Very High Alert)**, therefore, we ask that you:

- Use the one way system so that parents and children are travelling one way around the school. Please do not go through the exits for a short cut or because the weather is bad we **MUST** keep everyone safe.
- Adults and children over the age of 11 to wear a face mask when walking around the school grounds
- Keep 2m apart from each other when waiting to drop off or collect your children
- **DO NOT** send your child to school if anyone in your household has symptoms, is waiting for a test result or tests positive



Other guidance from the Government:

Walk or cycle where you can and plan ahead and avoid busy times and routes on public transport. **Avoid car sharing with anyone from outside your household or your support bubble.**

You **must not** meet socially indoors or in most outdoor places with anybody you do not live with, or who is not in your support bubble, this includes in any private garden or at most outdoor venues.
