Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January

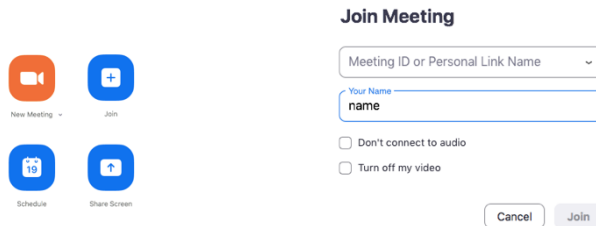

When joining the meeting, please put the child's first name so that the teacher can easily identify them.



Zoom meetings are an extension of the classroom and children should conduct themselves as they would in a classroom environment. This includes:

1. Taking part in a Zoom meeting in a safe and appropriate place with no bedrooms, inappropriate objects or inappropriate information visible.
2. Being on time for the virtual meeting
3. Being dressed appropriately for learning
4. Remaining attentive during sessions
5. Interacting patiently and respectfully with your teachers and peers
6. Not recording each other's online interactions
7. Finishing the session when your teacher instructs you to do so

- o Keep passwords confidential
- o Be responsible for my behaviour and actions when using technology, including the resources I access and the language I use
- o Make sure that all my communication with students, teachers and others using technology is responsible and sensible
