

Dear Friend,

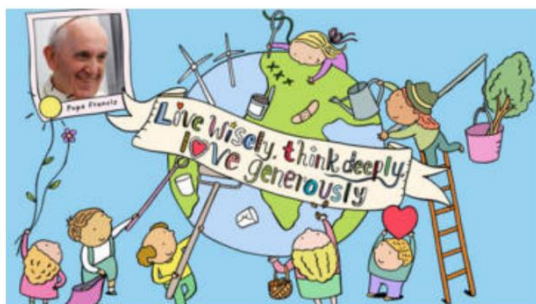
